We discussed more possibilities for venues to get YAS (Young Adult Survey) – if we can get an extension, it was suggested that a table be put up at Marathon Dance.

The After-Prom committee will be meeting. Amber will be contacting Erin Milligan (Vance), advisor, to schedule another meeting. Bill reported that we have approximately \$7,000 available from existing funding sources. Amber is following up on car donation from Carriage Traders.

Amber also updated the group on activity with the Anti-bullying Task Force, SADD, and tabling events. Monica suggested tabling on a budget vote day.

Parent University is scheduled for Wednesday, January 16th at 6:30 pm at the Moreau Community Center. Patty Kilgore will be presenting on what's trending with drugs. This should be an interesting and informative presentation that will also address vaping. There was a lengthy discussion on the severity of the vaping problem and how to start addressing it. Much of our DFC grant funds can be put toward this problem as we identified it as a substance to address in the grant application.

We discussed continuing to recruit members of the community, both kids and adults, to become involved with CCFW. They don't have to come all meetings. There are opportunities to get involved in other ways or with sub-committees. Amber met Martin Cohen, an attorney for children services who has a student in the high school. He is interested in getting involved with the Coalition.

We will be changing the name/domain of our website. Amber will be discussing moving forward with this initiative with Janine and Jill at the Prevention Council.
