After introductions, update on assessments was given by Lillian and Tom. The PNA was completed during gym classes – 12th grade participation seemed low. Tom reported that the YAS (Young Adult Survey) will be given in the next few weeks. This is the survey for the PFS grant that targets young adults between ages 18 and 25. This is a difficult demographic to capture. Some suggestions for places to focus on included the Kingpin Bowling Alley, Cool Beans, and basketball games. Tom also stated that he is going to apply for an extension through the end of January for this data.

Bill gave an update on the After-Prom Committee meeting. A save-the-date flyer has been distributed. The theme is Old Hollywood. Volunteers are needed – lots of discussion about the importance of getting some parents involved. The after-prom party will go to 2:00 am rather than 4:00 am as in the past. Mary Mann is the prom advisor. Prom date is 5/18/18.

Lillian shared that a new PFS Coordinator (Alexandria) will start in January to finish the last 8-9 months of the PFS grant, replacing James. Much of the work is data coordination at this point. Alex is a Public Health student.

Don Franks presented on the Remote Area Medical Program. This is a Tennessee-based group that goes around the country providing free medical/dental clinics to under-resourced and uninsured people in communities. Don is working with AHI to discuss bringing the program to our area. Hudson Headwaters and Glens Falls Hospital have expressed interest in the project. After the application is submitted, it is generally a year and a half before the clinic occurs. Kristine stated that 36% of SGF's population is considered economically disadvantaged.
