PNA – additional questions	 We administered the Prevention Needs Assessment survey last fall to grades 7-12 students under DFC grant PFS grant needs PNA data, so we will be administering it again to this year's 7-12 graders. PFS grant requires us to add a question specifically asking if "parents talk to you about opioids". Adding questions is a flat rate for up to 10 questions. We have 9 more questions that we can add at no extra cost. Meeting members suggested questions regarding vaping, specifically using the words vaping and juuling in the question. Other suggestions included asking if students know that nicotine is a lethal and addictive substance Discussion about adding ACES questions (Adverse Childhood Experiences) ACES has 10 questions on the survey. Members agree that we want to get ACES into the schools, but it needs to be done in full and not added onto a long survey. ACES has a protocol including parent letter and giving resources, could be re-traumatizing to those filling out the questions.
