CCFW Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CCFW, The Prevention Council and The Council for Prevention joined together to address the underage drinking party recently held in Wilton. The 3 agencies worked together to submit a letter to the editor of The Post Star and 4 billboards featuring the national campaign, Parents Who Host Lose the Most. - Members were reminded that Detera drug deactivation kits are available through CCFW for the SGF community and if anyone in the county needs Narcan kits or training, Kelly can assist in facilitating that need as we did for the SGF Police in December. Joey Boswell stated that he is also a NARCAN trainer.
- We recapped the CCFW promo item donation to the ARCC's Community Care bags as well as the Holiday Coping Guide put out in December.
- Kelly explained CRM (Community Relationship Management) software and how it could benefit CCFW's sustainability. CCFW applied to the South High Marathon Dance fund for \$5,000 to purchase the software. Reallocating funds in the current budget year is still a possibility to cover this expense.
- The year 9 DFC grant application will be due in February. Members were asked for any feedback related to action plans of interest for the grant. Joey Boswell asked if Tobacco use prevention will be addressed; it certainly can be and is usually addressed along with nicotine use. Kristine Orr raised the concern that the Coalition also address important topics such as suicide prevention. As a Coalition we certainly can address suicide prevention and other issues, we just cannot allocate DFC grant funds for this purpose unless we can "package" it along with substance use prevention as we all know how the issues are indelibly linked.
- Kelly asked if the members were interested in pursuing greater focus on marijuana use prevention in the next grant cycle with legalization expanding throughout the county. There were no specific responses though when asked about cannabis test kits that can detect THC in vape devices, Kathy Schnackenberg agreed these may be of value to parents and cited a recent conversation she had with a parent regarding vaping of THC.
